# **About Westport Land Conservation Trust (WLCT):**

Since its founding in 1972, the Westport Land Conservation Trust (WLCT) has supported the preservation of more than 5,000 acres in Westport, Massachusetts. WLCT is a private, non-governmental organization dedicated to local land conservation on behalf of the Westport community. WLCT seeks hard-working, people-oriented individuals motivated to make a difference within a dynamic and leading land conservation organization.

## **About the Position:**

WLCT is seeking a motivated and task-oriented individual to work closely with WLCT's Land Stewardship and Outreach Manager in stewarding over 1,600 acres of land currently held by WLCT. The Outreach and Stewardship Intern will be responsible for property maintenance, coordinating projects related to stewardship, and community engagement.

#### **Reports to:**

The Outreach and Stewardship Interns report to WLCT's Land Stewardship and Outreach Manager and work closely with volunteers and constituents to further the mission of WLCT.

## **Primary Position Responsibilities:**

### **Stewardship:**

- Provide weekly maintenance for all destination properties using hand tools, small motorized equipment and other tools required for general landscaping
- Coordinate volunteer(s) for appropriate stewardship projects (e.g. trail clearing, clean-ups)
- Assist staff with the creation of a new grassland meadow at Dunham's Brook, a large tree planting at Herb Hadfield and the creation of an outdoor classroom and community garden at Mill Pond Conservation area.

#### **Community Outreach and Volunteers:**

- Assist staff with events and summer programs
- Act as a WLCT representative while in and around the community of Westport
- Lead and support the Tuesday Trail Team volunteers as needed

## Other

- Support WLCT fundraising events as needed
- Support the Stewardship Program during annual monitoring of Conservation Restrictions
- May on occasion need to lift or assist in lifting objects over 50lbs
- May on occasion need to drive a WLCT company vehicle

- Experience with landscaping equipment

## Hours, Salary & Benefits:

The Outreach and Stewardship Summer Internships are 25 hours per week at \$15/hr for approximately 10 weeks. Typically, the work week for this position will be Tuesday-Thursday from 8am-4pm depending upon weather conditions. Some work on weekends will be required for special events.

The successful candidate will have a valid driver's license and be able to provide their own transportation.
